



DR. C.W. (BILL) GULLIKSON

September 11, 1928 - May 5, 2013

Dr. C.W. (Bill) Gullikson passed away on May 5, 2013. He was the son of C.M. and Helen (Strong) Gullikson, born September 11, 1928 in El Dorado, Kansas. Raised near Madison, Kansas, Bill was a drummer in the high school band and earned the Eagle Scout award. He spent a short time in the U.S. Army and graduated from Stanford University in 1951 with a B.S. in Physics. He attended the University of Oklahoma Graduate School earning his M.S. and Ph.D. degrees in Physics. He did research in the oil industry, cryogenics and air defense. He did some Russian-English translating for the Optical Society of America. In his field, he authored and presented several papers and published extensively. For the last 15 years of his industrial career he owned and directed the Western Environmental Testing Laboratory in Colorado Springs, CO. He taught physics at the Maui Community College for one year, moving to Prescott, AZ to accept a teaching job at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University in 1990.

His hobbies have included fishing and hunting, wood and metal working and volunteering with the Boy Scouts. He was a devoted Christian, and has “returned home” to be with His Father in Heaven.

He is survived by his loving wife Nancy of Prescott, AZ. They were married for 35 years. His children are Erik Charles (Kris) of Seeley Lake, MT, Grant Carter of Tacoma, WA, Lisa Lynn (Ron) Price of Bozeman, MT, Lisa Rose of Denver, CO and Eric B. (Michelle) of Prescott Valley, AZ and 4 grandchildren Kelsey, Trenton, Carter and Paige. His surviving sister is Ann Vilches of McKinney,

TX. Bill was preceded in death by his sister Jean Hawkins.

Bill will be greatly missed by his family and friends.
