Francis (Jerry) Jarrell, 93, of Prescott Valley, Ariz., passed away at home Aug. 16, 2017, and went to be with his Lord. He was born Jan. 18, 1924, to Booker and Cora Jarrell in Lebanon, Missouri. He then enlisted in the US Navy and was aboard a troop transport ship, USS General J.R. Brooke, from August 1943 to March 1946.
