Frank Hoyos Sr., 64, of Prescott Valley, Arizona, passed away Wednesday, Dec. 10, 2014, doing what he loved - helping his family and friends.

Francisco Jose Arvayo Hoyos was born Feb. 23, 1950, to Jose and Angela Hoyos in Cumpas, Sonora, Mexico. After graduating from high school and attending college in Mexico, Frank immigrated to America in the early 1970s.

Frank adored his wife Teresa (McCarter) Hoyos, whom he married on Nov. 23, 1978; daughter Annette Hoyos; son Frank (Nicole) Hoyos Jr. of California; stepdaughters, Kathey (Chadd) Sandberg of Kansas, Rhonda Holmes of Kansas and Cheryl Tolson; 12 grandchildren; and five great grandchildren.
