His subdivision became affectionately known by the residents as Timmons Village. In his retired years, George was an active Big Brother in the Big Brothers Big Sisters program in Prescott and helped numerous 'Littles' with reading proficiency. He was a friend to all and loved by so many.

George is survived by his three children, Jill, Gregg and Gary, as well as eight grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren.
