Jackie Lee Lyons, 73, went to be with his Lord on June 6, 2009 in Prescott Valley, Arizona. Born July 6, 1935 in Baxter Springs, Kansas to Floyd and Mary Lyons, his family moved to Tucson, AZ., in 1942. Jackie graduated from Tucson High School in 1954. He and Rita Jackson were married on October 7, 1955. He was a tech sergeant in the United States Air Force and served in England, France and South Carolina. He then trained in electronics and worked for the Federal Aviation Administration for the rest of his career, retiring as an F.A.A. manager for northern Arizona in 1990. Jackie and his family lived all over the western United States but called Arizona home. He enjoyed laughing, being with his family, fixing historic cars and trucks, fishing and gold panning.
