November 25, 1922 - January 26, 2010

Josephine J. Oneglia (nee) Badaluuco 87, of Prescott Valley, AZ died peacefully in her sleep, Tuesday January 26, 2010. She was born in New York City on November 25, 1922 Josephine, a soprano, sang many concerts including Waldorf Astoria, Carneige Hall, and Carl Fisher Hall. In New Jersey, during the 1960's and 1970's she was a lead singer at Our Lady of Mount Carmel in Ridgewood, a soloist for weddings and funerals. She was active in plays for OLMC, Ridgewood High School Jamboree, Gilbert and Sullivan Opera, Ridgewood Singers, and Pro Arte Chorale , among others. She was a patron of the arts including the Metropolitan Opera Company. She created handicrafts, including wire trees and quilts. She was an Italian gourmet cook and made rice balls, a known favorite of family and friends. Josephine was preceded in death by her husband, Frank V. Oneglia, LTCol, USAF retired, and her brother Anthony Badaluuco. She is survived by daughter Anita L. Oneglia of Prescott Valley, AZ; son Peter F Onegflia of Hackensak, New Jersey; grandsons, Peter V. Oneglia, Michael P. Oneglia and daughter-in-law Kathryn A. Oneglia of Hawthorne New Jersey, and many nieces and nephews.
