Kathleen Ann Angiulo, affectionately known as Kathy, passed away on April 30, 2026, at the age of 79 in Dewey, Arizona. Born on November 13, 1946, Kathy embarked on a life marked by devotion to her family and an unwavering commitment to community service.

Kathy's educational journey began at The Mary Louis Academy and continued at Queens College in New York City.
